- 6 billion doses have been administered worldwide.
- Vaccines alone will not end this pandemic. We have many other tools to stop transmission and save lives: effective public health tools, and effective medical tools. We must use them all.
- We seek your commitment to stay the course with a comprehensive, risk-based approach to prevent transmission and save lives.
 - An uninterrupted supply chain to move vaccines from manufacturing to delivery is vital. But right now, there are many gaps and blockages along the way.
 - Right now, 2.4 billion doses of COVID-19 vaccines are needed to vaccinate the world's most at risk people: health workers, the
 elderly, those with underlying conditions and other vulnerable groups. The vaccines exist, but they are still not reaching the people
 who need them most.
 - Almost 90% of wealthier countries have now reached the 10% target. But 50 countries will not get there, mostly in Africa.
 - WHO set the world a challenge, to vaccinate 10% of the population of every country by the end of September, 40% by the end of this year, and 70% by the middle of next year. Almost 90% of wealthier countries have now reached the 10% target. But 50 countries will not get there, mostly in Africa.
 - The longer vaccine inequity persists, the more the virus will keep circulating and changing, the longer the social and economic disruption will continue, and the higher the chances that more variants will emerge that render vaccines less effective.
 - So far, COVAX has shipped more than 260 million doses to 141 countries. But as you know, COVAX has also faced several
 challenges, with manufacturers prioritizing bilateral deals and many high-income countries tying up the global supply of vaccines














Geographic distribution of COVID-19
